Ecoregions are large landscape areas defined by climate, physical characteristics, and the plants and animals living there.


# Factors used in determining Great Lakes coastal ecoregion quality:

- Characteristic shoreline types
- Significant natural communities
- Existing representation in parks/protected areas
- Priority unprotected features
- Urban area within shoreline watersheds


# (More) Factors used in determining Great Lakes coastal ecoregion quality:

- Agriculture within shoreline watersheds
- Residential/cottage/marina shoreline use
- Lake edge armoured against erosion
- Rate of land-use change
- Planning/restoration activities under way
- Trend in shoreline health


## "A" Rated Ecoregion
