



EPA Begins Review of Sparta Landfill Superfund Site Sparta, Michigan

U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, with assistance from the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality, is reviewing the effectiveness of the cleanup at the Sparta Landfill Superfund site, Sparta Township, Mich. The Superfund law requires five-year reviews of sites where the cleanup is either done or in progress but hazardous waste remains managed on-site. These five-year reviews are done to ensure that the cleanup remains effective and protects human health and the environment.

The cleanup plan chose continued ground water monitoring.

Five-year reviews look at:

- site information.
- how the cleanup was done.
- how well the cleanup is working.
- any future actions needed.
