Industrial Source Complex 3 (ISC3) Model (Spanish version). Revised 10/2000.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) U.S.-Mexico Border Information Center on Air Pollution (i.e., "Centro de Información sobre Contaminación de Aire" or "CICA") has prepared and made available a Spanish language version of EPA's Industrial Source Complex 3 (ISC3) regulatory model. This Model was revised in October, 2000. CICA is also making available at this site a Spanish version of EPA's PCRAMMET program. PCRAMMET is a preprocessor for meteorological data that is used with ISC3 and other EPA models. You will need PCRAMMET to run ISC3.
