

MOTOR FUEL

Highway use of motor fuel in 1979 decreased by 2.4 percent from 1978, and is expected to decrease by 4 percent in 1980 from 1979 levels. Motor-fuel revenues, up 0.7 percent in 1979 over 1978, are also expected to decrease by about 4 percent even though nine States increased their tax rates during the year.

The decreases occurred even though motor fuel was readily available in 1980, and were partly due to decreased travel and partly due to increasing fuel efficiency. The fuel efficiency average for all vehicles has shown continued improvement---1976, 12.20 miles per gallon (mpg); in 1977, 12.32 mpg; in 1978, 12.38 mpg; and in 1979, 12.52 mpg.

MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATIONS

Motor vehicle registrations in the Nation increased from 148,777,965 in 1978 to 154,118,099 in 1979, an increase of 3.6 percent. Motor vehicle revenues increased 6.2 percent. It is estimated that 1980 registrations will exceed 1979 by 3.2 percent for a total of 159,029,000.

DRIVER LICENSING

The 143.3 million total licensed drivers in 1979 reflects a 1.7 percent increase over 1978, and a 1.6 percent increase is expected in 1980. The rate of increase seems to be slowing somewhat, perhaps due to a declining birth rate since the late 1950's and a saturation of the driving-age population. In 1979, 84.3 percent of persons 15 and over were licensed drivers.

The male portion of the drivers, 53.41 percent, increased 1.2 percent, while the female segment increased by 2.3 percent over 1978. Drivers aged 24 years and under make up 21.54 percent of the total licensed drivers.

There was almost one driver per registered automobile, and each driver averaged 9,370 vehicle miles of travel.

HIGHWAY FINANCE

Highway-user imposts, consisting of motor-fuel and motor-vehicle taxes, provided about 61 percent of the total receipts for highways by all units of government in 1979. Total receipts amounted to \$37.5 billion, an increase of 5.5 percent over 1978. This increase came largely from non-user sources, up \$1.7 billion in 1979 or 15 percent over 1978.

Total highway expenditures exceeded \$37.5 billion, a 12.5 percent increase over 1978. Capital outlay amounted to almost \$17.5 billion or 46 percent of total expenditures, an increase of almost 18 percent over 1978. The construction price index, now over 3 times the 1967 base year, rose 43.3 points, or 16.3 percent over 1978. The highway maintenance and operation index rose 21 points or 9.5 percent from 1978 to 1979, and is almost 2½ times the 1967 base.

At the State level, highway-user imposts contributed almost 82 percent of the total \$18.5 billion of State highway funds. Total State receipts for highways in 1979 increased almost 4 percent over 1978. Total State expenditures exceeded \$23 billion in 1979, an increase of 14 percent over 1978. Capital outlay, up 20 percent over 1978, accounted for over 57 percent of total expenditures.

ROADWAY MILEAGE

Roads and streets in the United States, as of December 31, 1979, totaled approximately 3.92 million miles, a 0.8 percent increase from the 1978 figure. Over the past 50 years, mileage in the United States has increased approximately 645,000 miles, an annual increase of 0.4 percent.

VEHICLE MILES


Highway travel in the United States is estimated to have topped 1,529 billion vehicle miles in 1979---a decrease of 1 percent over the previous year.

The Federal-Aid Interstate System accounts for about 1 percent of the Nation's total route mileage and carries 19 percent of the travel. The arterial class highways (including Interstate) represent 10 percent of the mileage and carry 68 percent of the travel. All arterial and collector highways combined, which include 30 percent of the Nation's mileage, carry 85 percent of the travel.

MICELLANEOUS

Expenditures per mile average \$16,497 and \$5,017 per mile for capital outlay and maintenance respectively, compared to 10.85 per 1,000 vehicle-miles-of-travel and 107.75 per registered vehicle. Some of the variations among States may be easier to visualize by considering total road and street miles per 1,000 persons, with the most populous States exceeding 60 miles per 1,000 persons.






TOTAL RECEIPTS FOR HIGHWAYS, BY GOVERNMENTAL UNITS 1921 - 1979




STATE RECEIPTS AND DISBURSEMENTS FOR HIGHWAYS 1979 (IN BILLIONS OF DOLLARS)







(IN DOLLARS PER 1,000 VEHICLE MILES)**







(IN DOLLARS PER 1,000 VEHICLE MILES)**




