

MOTOR FUEL

Highway use of motor fuel in 1981 declined to 115.0 billion gallons, a decrease of 0.4 percent from 1980, and is expected to remain about the same in 1982. Motor-fuel revenues, up 4.1 percent in 1981 from 1980, are expected to increase by about 6.4 percent in 1982, reflecting the full effect of the tax increases which took place during 1981 in more than half the States.

The slight decrease in fuel usage occurred even though motor fuel was readily available, prices were relatively stable, and travel was up. This was due, at least in part, to the continuing increases in the fuel efficiency of the vehicle fleet which had increased from 11.85 mpg in 1973 to 13.23 mpg in 1980, and rose again in 1981 to 13.55 mpg.

MOTOR-VEHICLE REGISTRATIONS

Motor-vehicle registrations in the Nation increased from 155,796,219 in 1980 to 158,456,511 in 1981, an increase of 1.7 percent. Motor-vehicle revenues increased 5.6 percent, primarily due to increases in registration fees. It is estimated that 1982 registrations will exceed 1981 by 1.3 percent for a total of 160,443,000. Revenues from motor-vehicle registrations are estimated to increase by 8.5 percent.

DRIVER LICENSING

The 147.1 million total licensed drivers in 1981 reflects a 1.2 percent increase over 1980. A 1.3 percent increase is expected in 1982. The rate of increase seems to be slowing somewhat, perhaps due to a declining birth rate since the late 1950's and a saturation of the driving-age population. In 1981, 82.6 percent of persons 15 and over were licensed drivers.

Total male drivers increased 0.9 percent, while total female drivers increased by 1.6 percent over 1980. Drivers aged 24 years and under make up 20.56 percent of the total licensed drivers.

There were 1.9 drivers per registered automobile, and each driver averaged 9,282 vehicle miles of total travel.

HIGHWAY FINANCE

Highway-user imposts consisting of motor-fuel taxes, motor-vehicle taxes and fees, and highway tolls, provided about 58 percent of the total receipts for highways by all units of government in 1981. Total receipts amounted to \$40.8 billion, an increase of 3.1 percent over 1980. The increase came primarily from user sources, up \$1.3 billion, or 5.7 percent, from 1980.

Total highway expenditures amounted to a little more than \$41 billion for 1981, down slightly from 1980. Capital outlay dropped \$1.5 billion to \$18.8 billion, a 7.5 percent decline. The highway construction price index also dropped 6.3 points in 1981. Nonetheless, the real investment in highways declined by 3.8 percent. Conversely, the highway maintenance and operation index rose 11.7 points or 8.7 percent from 1980 to 1981. Maintenance and operation costs accounted for \$11.7, up 2.7 percent from 1980, billion or 28.5 percent of total highway expenditures for 1981. In real dollars, however, highway maintenance and operation expenditures declined by 5.5 percent from 1980.

At the State level, highway-user imposts accounted for 80 percent of the total \$20.9 billion in State highway receipts for 1981. Total State receipts for highways in 1981 increased 6.1 percent over 1980. State highway expenditures totaled \$25.4 billion in 1981, a decrease of about \$500 million from 1980. Capital outlay accounted for 55 percent of total state expenditures, down 8.7 percent from 1980.

ROADWAY MILEAGE AND HIGHWAY TRAVEL

Existing public roads and streets in the United States, as of December 31, 1981, totaled approximately 3.85 million miles, down slightly from the 1980 figure because of improvements in reporting.


Highway travel in the United States has increased to an estimated 1,550 billion vehicle miles in 1981 -- an increase of about 1.5 percent from the previous year.

The Interstate System accounts for about 1 percent of the Nation's total route mileage and carries 19 percent of the travel. The arterial class highways (including Interstate) represent 10 percent of the mileage and carry 69 percent of the travel. All arterial and collector highways combined, which include 31 percent of the Nation's mileage, carry 86 percent of the travel.

MISCELLANEOUS

Expenditures per mile average 16,877 and 5,481 per mile for capital outlay and maintenance respectively. State highway-user revenue per 1,000 vehicle miles of travel averaged \$10.93 for all States.










TOTAL RECEIPTS FOR HIGHWAYS, BY GOVERNMENTAL UNITS
















(IN DOLLARS PER 1,000 VEHICLE MILES)


