SUBJECT

Collar/Side Panel Format for 1:250,000-Scale Quadrangle Maps

BACKGROUND

Quadrangle maps at 1:250,000-scale are produced with either standard format or side panel collar treatment, depending on the procedure under which the map is being revised. 1:250,000-scale quadrangle maps which cover portions of Mexican territory will contain a four-language collar patterned after Pan American Institute of Geography and History (PAIGH) specifications. The following is a clarification of the instructions regarding the collar/side panel format to be used for all 1:250,000-scale USGS maps.

INSTRUCTIONS

All USGS 1:250,000-scale quadrangle maps which cover a portion of Mexico will be modified at the time of either limited or complete revision to show in the collar a glossary, legend, and other pertinent information in four languages: English, Spanish, Portuguese, and French. The attached style sheet shows the collar layout and content for the PAIGH formatted maps.

Collar/side panel treatments for all other 1:250,000-scale maps depend on whether the map is updated by limited or complete revision procedures. Maps which are updated by limited revision procedures will continue to show the standard format collar. As maps are completely revised, the collar will be reformatted to the side panel treatment which is designed for folding. Refer to "Supplemental Topographic Instructions: Working Draft for 1:250,000-Scale Quadrangle Maps, 1984" and to "1:250,000-Scale Quadrangle Map Style Sheet" (in preparation).
