



Plate 80.—Classification: SYSTEM Palustrine, CLASS Scrub-Shrub Wetland, SUBCLASS Broad-leaved Evergreen, DOMINANCE TYPE *Cyrilla racemiflora*, WATER REGIME Saturated, WATER CHEMISTRY Fresh-Acid, SOIL Organic. Subordinate plants include: honeycup (*Zenobia pulverulenta*), leatherleaf (*Chamaedaphne calyculata*), peat moss (*Sphagnum* spp.), highbush blueberry (*Vaccinium corymbosum*), loblolly bay (*Gordonia lasianthus*), pond pine (*Pinus serotina*), and highbush blueberry (*Vaccinium corymbosum*).
