The State's FFY 2006 reported data for this indicator are 59.2% based on data from three of its EIS programs.</p> <p>OSEP was unable to determine progress or slippage because data for one of the three EIS programs were included in the FFY 2006 APR but not included in the FFY 2005 APR.</p> <p>The State did not meet its target of 100%.</p> <p>The State did not account for untimely services for two of the three EIS programs for which it provided FFY 2006 data but reported that it had put in place mechanisms to collect that information for future submissions.</p> <p>The State reported that one EIS program, NEIS-Northwest, had not corrected the finding of noncompliance related to this indicator identified in FFYs 2004 and 2005 in a timely manner. For this uncorrected finding of noncompliance, the State reported that, in December 2006, it conducted a focused review on this EIS program to determine the underlying causes of the noncompliance (which included an approximately 30% increase in referrals and personnel shortages) and has required a follow-up corrective action plan.</p> | <p>The State reported that noncompliance identified in FFYs 2004 and 2005 with the timely service provision requirements in 34 CFR §§303.340(c), 303.342(e) and 303.344(f)(1) was not corrected. There is no expectation that an increase in that percentage is necessary. OSEP appreciates the State's efforts to improve performance and expects that the State is monitoring to ensure that IFSP teams are making service setting decisions on an individualized basis and in compliance with 34 CFR §§303.12, 303.18, and 303.344(d)(1)(ii).</p>  |
