<p><b>Indicator 9</b> In its FFY 2003 APR, the State reported that: (1) it determined a component to be in compliance if it had a weighted total of 90-100%; and (2) the State grouped program requirements or “indicators” into “components.” In its September 8, 2005 response to the APR, OSEP required the State to describe, in its SPP, how the State ensures full (100%) compliance with Part C requirements. (34 CFR §303.351)</p>	<p>On pages 19–27 of the SPP, the State provided a detailed description of the Lead Agency’s procedures for identifying and correcting noncompliance. On page 21 of the SPP and in a telephone conversation of February 10, 2006, the State clarified that it requires corrective action and ensures correction of all noncompliance, regardless of the percentage of noncompliance.</p>	<p>The State provided the required clarification.</p>	<p>OSEP looks forward to the State’s updated data for Indicator 9 in the APR due February 1, 2007.</p>
