OSEP's November 14, 2005 Verification Visit letter identified two general supervision issues: (1) timely correction of State-identified noncompliance under 34 CFR §303.501(b); and (2) dissemination of notice under 34 CFR §303.403.</p> <p>(1) With respect to timely correction of Part C noncompliance identified by the State, in the Part C SPP, the State was required to include monitoring and correction data for all regions monitored (including Region 14) and provide correction data for when Region 14 resolved all findings of noncompliance. If the data reflected that Region 14 or other regions had not appropriately corrected findings by IDE, IDE was required to include in the SPP or within 60 days of the date of the November 14, 2005 Verification Visit letter, its plan with strategies, evidence of change, and targets to ensure the correction of noncompliance identified through its monitoring within one year of its identification.</p> <p>(2) In addition, in the SPP, IDE was required to confirm that it is providing parents of children enrolled in the Iowa Early Access Part C program with the revised notice that meets the content requirements of 34 CFR §303.403(b).</p>	<p>(1) On January 5, 2006, IDE submitted the required documentation that was also submitted in the SPP that demonstrated that the State has ensured compliance with the timely correction component of Indicator #9 (including correction data for Region 14).</p> <p>(2) In the SPP and the documentation provided, IDE referenced a submission of required revisions to IDE's Prior Written Notice Form under 34 CFR §303.403 and that OSEP approved the revisions.</p>	<p>(1) OSEP appreciates the State's efforts in ensuring compliance with this requirement.</p> <p>(2) IDE indicated in its SPP and January 2006 submission that it would disseminate the revised notice as required under 34 CFR §303.403.</p>	<p>(1) OSEP looks forward to reviewing data in the APR, due February 1, 2007, demonstrating continuing compliance with this requirement.</p> <p>(2) In its FFY 2006 Part C Application, IDE must include its written assurance (as part of the assurance under Section 639 of IDEA) that it is disseminating when required by 34 CFR §303.403(a) the revised notice that meets the content requirements of 34 CFR §303.403(b). In addition, OSEP looks forward to reviewing in the APR, due February 1, 2007, the State's baseline data in response to Indicator #4 regarding family outcomes including whether parents know their rights.</p>
