IFSPs for 73% of all children exiting EarlySteps with an IFSP that included transition steps and services. B. Notification to the local school system occurred for 76% of children who were exiting Part C and were identified as potentially eligible for Part B. C. Timely transition conferences occurred for 81% of the children exiting Part C who were identified as potentially eligible for Part B. 	<p>The State must ensure that the noncompliance reported under 8A, 8B and 8C is corrected within one year of its identification and include data in the APR, due February 1, 2007, that demonstrate compliance with the requirements of 8A, 8B and 8C. The State should review and, if necessary revise, its improvement strategies included in the SPP to ensure they will enable the State to include data in the APR, that demonstrate full compliance with the requirements of 8A, 8B and 8C. Failure to demonstrate full compliance at that time may affect OSEP's determination of the State's status under 616(d) of the IDEA.</p>
