## Dear Chairman Miller:

On behalf of the American Association of Colleges for Teacher Education, I am pleased to write in support of passage of HR 4137, the College Opportunity and Affordability Act. This legislation includes several provisions which will strengthen the preparation of teachers in institutions of higher education. The partnership grants in Title II rightly focus on clinical preparation by targeting mentoring, induction and residential preparation models. Research clearly indicates that strong clinical preparation yields teachers who are more effective in the classroom and who stay longer.
