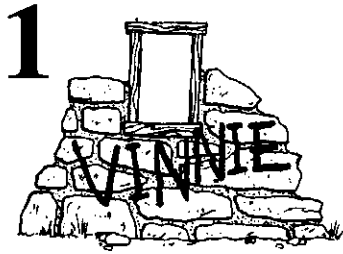
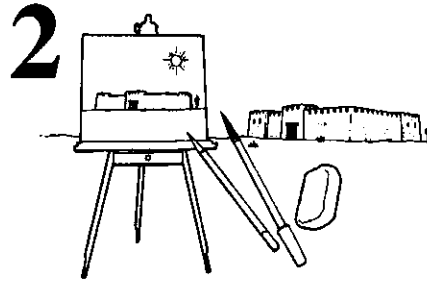


The Past: Can You Dig It?

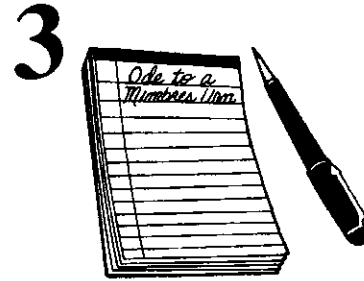
