General Economic Indicators

Consumer Price Index:
This release estimates cost of living increases. It does so by measuring the average change in prices of goods and services purchased by households over time. This measure is based on the current price of a fixed list of goods and services commonly purchased by consumers, which is then divided by the price of the same list during the base year and multiplied by 100.

The CPI is based on a measure of the prices of day-to-day goods and services one might purchase, such as clothing, food, shelter, transportation sales, etc. Those prices that are used to calculate the CPI are gathered in 87 urban areas and from about 23,000 retail and service establishments throughout the country. To calculate the index, price changes for various items in each location are averaged together with weights, which emphasize their significance in the spending of the fitting population group. The local numbers are then combined to acquire a U.S. city average.
