DIGEST:

Correctness of wage determination issued by the Department of Labor is not subject to review by GAO and protest alleging incorrectness of such wage determination is dismissed.

Aleman Food Service Inc. protests the correctness and applicability of a wage scale specified in invitation for bids No. N00612-81-B-0015 issued by the Naval Regional Medical Center, Jacksonville, Florida.

This Office, pursuant to judicial decisions construing the Secretary of Labor's authority to make determinations of prevailing wages, does not review the correctness of wage determinations issued by the Department of Labor (DOL) in situations such as we have in the present case. A challenge to a Service Contract Act wage determination should be processed through the administrative procedures established by DOL. See G. W. Galloway Company, B-193940, January 30, 1979, 79-1 CPD 74.

The protest is dismissed.
