## ATF ANNOUNCES \$3,000 REWARD IN FULTON GUN SHOP BURGLARY

FULTON, Mo. – The Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) and the Fulton Police Department announced today a joint reward of up to \$3,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of those responsible for the Jan. 8 burglary of Brigg's Gun Shop in Fulton.

The follow-up investigation revealed a number of handguns and long guns as well as various calibers of ammunition were taken from the federal firearms licensee, located at 1225 South Business Highway 54.
