

Managing 2006 and 2007 S2S Endpoints through the Transition to Adobe

Overview



- Both the 2006 (PureEdge) and 2007 (Adobe) systems are in service during the transition.
- Agencies can post opportunity packages to both the 2006 (PureEdge) and 2007 (Adobe) systems.
- Note: Applicants visiting grants.gov "see" opportunities posted by agencies on both systems.
- S2S connections <u>REQUIRE</u> Agency ATTENTION!

Transition Dates



Transition Period	Functionality Available
Now through 5/31/2008	•All users have full functionality.
6/1/2008 through 9/30/2008	 Grantors should no longer create PureEdge applications unless granted an exception by the PMO. Applicants, however, can submit PureEdge applications.
10/1/2008 through 3/31/2009	•Grantors should ensure that there are no opportunities with closing dates after 9/30/2008 unless granted an exception by Grants.gov.
4/1/2009	 The 2006 system will be taken offline. Grantors will be notified to retrieve any packages they may have loaded on the 2006 system prior to taking the system offline.

Posting Opportunities and Packages

 Agencies can post opportunity packages to both the 2006 (PureEdge) and 2007 (Adobe) systems!

Submissions



- All Submissions made to 2006 system (PureEdge) opportunities
 - Using PureEdge are stored in 2006 system
 - Using Applicant S2S 2006-endpoint are stored in 2006 system
 - Using Applicant S2S 2007-endpoint are stored in 2007 system and
 - They will "look and feel" like 2007 submissions (see the grants.gov website for Adobe and PureEdge FAQs at: http://www.grants.gov/help/faq.jsp)

Submissions



- All Submissions made to 2007 system opportunities
 - Using Adobe are stored in the 2007 system
 - Using Applicant S2S 2007-endpoint are stored in the 2007 system

Retrieving Submissions



- Agencies can download, acknowledge, assign tracking numbers to submissions stored in the 2006 and 2007 systems through the 2007 Endpoint
- Agencies can download, acknowledge, assign tracking numbers to submissions <u>stored</u> in the 2006 system through the 2006 Endpoint
- To retrieve submissions to the 2007 System, via S2S, Agencies must use the 2007 endpoint

Grants.gov Tracking numbers



- Tracking numbers of a 2007 system submission begin as GRANT followed by the number 1
 - Example Grant1xxxxxxx
- Tracking numbers of a 2006 system submission made using the Applicant-S2S 2007 endpoint begin as GRANT followed by the number 1
 - Example Grant1xxxxxxx
- Tracking numbers of a 2006 system submission made using the Applicant-S2S 2006 system endpoint begin as Grant followed by the number 0
 - Example Grant0xxxxxxx

Endpoints



- 2007 Endpoint or Port: To access 2007 System web services use the following endpoints:
 - Production-2007: https://ws07.grants.gov:446/agency-s2s-server/services/
 - AT07: https://at07web.grants.gov:446/agency-s2s-server/services/
- 2006 Endpoint or Port: To access 2006 web services use the following endpoints:
 - Production-2006: https://ws.grants.gov:446/agency-s2s-server/services/
 - ATWEB: https://atws.grants.gov:446/agency-s2s-server/services/

Certificates



- Certificates: New certificates are not needed for the 2007 System.
 - Existing 2006 certificates can be used.
 - Note: Firewall port 446 should be open to S2S endpoints. Please see previous 'EndPoints' slide for details.
