Market Trends


- Although potatoes have excellent nutritional qualities, demand for fresh potatoes softened between 1999 and 2002 perhaps due to dieting trends and consumer perception of high carbohydrate levels in tubers.
- Potato yields were up in 2004, but potato prices stayed under \$6.00 per cwt for the second consecutive year.
- Consumer interest continues to increase in gold, blue, and red potato varieties. Niche marketers can combine this interest with nutritional information about potatoes to expand specialty potato sales.
- Consumers continue to demand smaller potato quantities. Individually wrapped baking potatoes and 1-5 pound plastic clamshell containers are used for marketing smaller quantities of potatoes to the consumer.


