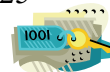

This award recognizes outstanding educational programs, methods, techniques, and activities that give visibility to family and consumer sciences (FCS) elementary and secondary education and support "No Child Left Behind".

Said Ludwig, "Winning this prestigious national award is an incredible experience, but to win this award teaching a subject matter that I dearly love and am very passionate about, is both totally awesome and very humbling at the same time!"

In 2000, Ludwig implemented her award-winning fashion program for pregnant and parenting teens, "The Fabric of Life," to help them improve their self-confidence and emotional stability, gain experience and knowledge about starting an entrepreneurial business, learn the skills necessary to obtain entry level positions in the field of computerized embroidery, and participate in FCCLA chapter activities and competitions.

Ludwig is a 1973 University of Kentucky Home Economics graduate and has been employed at Westport since 1994.
