Background:

The Department of Veterans Affairs Vocational Rehabilitation and Employment Service (VR&E) contracts with authorized vendors and service providers for approved and necessary activities to enable service connected disabled veterans to successfully obtain suitable employment or improve their independence in daily living.

Goal:

VR&E Service, Contracting Expenditures pilot goal is to increase the participation for all Faith Based and Non Profits Organizations who are able to provide specialized rehabilitation services to assist service connected disabled veterans transitioning into employment, or if not employable, achieve maximum independence in activities of daily living.

VR&E contracts for vocational assessments, case management, employment services and various specialized services to improve the rehabilitation potential and job readiness skills of VR&E participants.
