Exhibit D encounter data submission requirement clarification	It was clarified that Exhibit D requires 50% of claims <u>adjudicated</u> in a month be submitted as encounter data in that month, regardless of the date of service. The issue seems to be primarily one of workload for PH Tech.	Contractors using PH Tech will discuss the need for compliance with this requirement.	None

Review of contract language revisions matrix for 2008	<p>Highlights of discussion items (housekeeping items not included):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Change in enrollment protocol for CAF children will effect those in BRS placements only; OYA children in BRS placements are not included in the enrollment change ▪ Revised Section K will list all required reports, including those referenced in other parts of the contract ▪ Section K also adds requirement for outcomes data submission for children approved for ISA; there was agreement that collecting outcome data is a good thing but plans believe how and where data is collected should not be prescribed contractually; agreed to placeholder language in the contract for 2008 with further discussion of actual 	Contractors will review materials and handouts in detail for final discussion and approval at May meeting.
