Placing children with the family members is making the best placement for children. Family search placements may need to take place multiple times now and for years in the future. Shirley Beau-Miller: (by phone call), from Washington County, is doing very well in this area. Kevin Campbell: For a subset of these children the MHOs may want to engage in a common effort to find family members in order to place these children.</li> </ul> <p>Jim Russell: What can MHO's count on from CW? He would like to have <b>more</b> of whatever is currently happening.</p> <p>David Hidalgo: What can be done before the child is too old to be in the system?</p> <p>CW: The MHOs are mandated to do a relative search. Review of a relative search may look at those who may not have been available the first go around.</p>	<p>Identify before placement. What can be done? Use the Internet for finding relatives' locations. Look at future rates, MHO asking AMH for possible increase to better facilitate relative search.</p>
