To the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives

On February 3, 1998, the President submitted to the Congress his first special impoundment message for fiscal year 1998. The message reports eight deferrals of budget authority, numbers D98-1 through D98-8. We have reviewed the deferrals contained in the first special message and found them to be in accordance with the Impoundment Control Act, 2 U.S.C. § 681, et seq., as amended.

Enclosure I provides specific information with regard to three of the deferrals reported in the first special message. Enclosure II lists the deferrals as submitted by the President in his special message.
