

**Peregrine Falcon Road to Recovery**

1970—Peregrine falcon is added to Endangered Species List

Recovery teams develop Regional recovery plans

Recovery actions implemented, including:

- Protect/enhance habitat,
- Minimize disturbance/mortality,
- Monitor contaminants (DDT),
- Reintroduce captive-bred birds

Recovery objectives achieved including number of breeding pairs

June 30, 1995—Notice of intent to propose delisting of the peregrine falcon

Publish proposal to delist species, August 25, 1998

90-day public comment period

USFWS evaluates comments

USFWS issues final decision to delist the peregrine falcon.



*Peregrine is at this stage.*

Once the peregrine is delisted, the Service will monitor its status for a minimum of five years

If status declines significantly, the species can be relisted

If status remains stable or improves, ESA monitoring is ended.
