HDER Program Developments

- FY 2004 second quarter deliveries have been made to Kansas, Mississippi, and Oregon
- Advanced Radiological Survey Techniques Training sessions have been delivered to New York and Mississippi. Upcoming courses have been scheduled for Tulsa, OK and Meridian, MS. HDER Training sessions have also been confirmed for Selma, AL and Peoria, IL.

New Release Time for Inventory List

ODP has implemented a change to the HDER Services Management Tool (SMT). All inventory lists will now be posted before noon on the first day of the new quarter, but will be "locked" until noon EST. This enhancement was made to facilitate better state POC management of the ordering process across the nation.

Separation of Training and Equipment Requests

All responders who receive equipment from the HDER Program should be appropriately trained. One training option is the HDER training course, which helps ensure that responders realize maximum benefit from the HDER Program. State and local agencies may request training independently of an equipment request.

- Local responder agencies should contact their state HDER point of contact (POC) to request training.
- If the state HDER POC has already submitted his or her state's quarterly services request,

- then the state POC may contact the ODP Centralized Scheduling and Information Desk (CSID) to schedule training.
- If the state HDER POC has not yet submitted his or her state's quarterly services request, then the state HDER POC should indicate that the state wishes to receive training by selecting the "Training requested" radial button on his or her services request (submitted via the HDER Services Management Tool on the secure ODP portal). If only training is requested, state POCs should also select the "No equipment requested" button.

Personnel Contamination Monitors

The HDER Program has recently received in its inventory several Personnel Contamination Monitors. These monitors are included in the quarter's inventory list which was posted on April 1, 2004. These units have an estimated value of \$33,000/unit and have been refurbished for inclusion in the HDER Program.
