# **HDER Program Developments**

- The FY03Q2 Services Request Form was sent to State HDER points of contact in January 2003. ODP is currently processing these requests and conducting conference calls with DOE and the State HDER points of contact for those metro areas that have requested equipment.
- The HDER Program Pilot Project will come to an end on March 31, 2003 paving the way for the HDER Program to go nationwide in summer 2003. ODP will seek your input on the HDER Program Pilot Project and then create a HDER Program Pilot Project Final Report.
- ODP is sending letters to the State Administrative Agency (SAA) points of contact in all U.S. States, the District of Columbia and the U.S. Territories (who did not participate in the pilot) announcing the HDER Program and asking them to assign a State HDER point of contact for their State. A letter will also be sent to each of the current State HDER points of contact announcing that the HDER Program is now going nationwide.
- ODP is officially part of the Department of Homeland Security as of March 1, 2003.

## **HPS Mid Year Conference- HDER Training Sessions**

The Office for Domestic Preparedness (ODP) and the Health Physics Society (HPS) sponsored HDER Program training sessions on January 29, 2003 and January 30, 2003 at the HPS Annual Mid-Year Meeting in San Antonio, Texas.
