Dear Senator Grassley:

On behalf of our client, Zimmer Holdings, Inc., I am writing in response to your letter of February 26, 2008 to David Dvorak, requesting information about the steps that Zimmer is taking, or planning to take, to enhance the transparency of its financial relationships with medical organizations. Zimmer appreciates your focus on transparency in the medical industry and is pleased to share with you the efforts Zimmer is making in that regard.

As a worldwide leader in providing orthopaedic and other medical devices, Zimmer is focused on meeting the profound needs of an aging population at a time when the rise of arthritis, obesity, and other chronic conditions, as well as the ongoing burden of debilitating acute conditions, will drive healthcare consumption and productivity losses to unprecedented levels. Zimmer believes it is essential to understand and address what it will take for the Company and the industry to meet the needs of the patients of the future and the healthcare systems that serve them.

The medical device industry has transformed patients' lives through a rare combination of clinical knowledge and engineering, bringing the insights of highly skilled physicians who work directly with patients together with the technical knowledge of engineers who design and build safe and effective devices. This collaboration has been the heart of a product development model that continues to identify and address profound unmet patient needs. Because physician skill level is a key driver of successful patient outcomes, physician training on the safe and effective use of today's complex products and procedures has also been central to the significant benefits patients have experienced with medical devices. Zimmer appreciates the fact that you and Senator Kohl, in introducing the Physicians Payments Sunshine Act, recognized the

importance of collaboration in the medical device industry. As you know, the Act focuses not on eliminating all collaboration, but rather on determining models for appropriate and necessary collaboration, including transparency.

Zimmer believes that it is time to change the historical model for collaborative relationships in order to inspire confidence and trust, while preserving the best of the collaboration that drives innovation and advances effective patient care. As you are aware, in April 2003, the Department of Health and Human Services' Office of the Inspector General (OIG) issued voluntary compliance guidance to pharmaceutical manufacturers, to help them prevent healthcare fraud and abuse by promoting a high level of ethical and lawful corporate conduct. While this guidance only addressed medical device manufacturers in a short footnote, Zimmer and the medical device industry took action. In 2003, the medical device industry association, the Advanced Medical Technology Association (AdvaMed), was working on developing its Code of Ethics on Interactions with Healthcare Professionals. This Code of Ethics became effective in January 2004.

In 2003, Zimmer's continuous consideration of its own compliance standards, combined with these measures taken by the OIG and AdvaMed, prompted the Company to re-evaluate its model for the management of conflicts of interest that may result from collaboration with healthcare professionals. This re-evaluation led to the implementation of Zimmer's enhanced Corporate Compliance Program in 2005. This Program, which has been recognized as "best practice" by an independent industry ethics organization, is robust. The Program includes extensive policies and operating procedures, numerous forms and instructions, training programs and a Code of Conduct. These materials were all designed and implemented with the assistance of top industry advisors. Zimmer is building upon that solid foundation by applying further discipline to ensure that collaboration is transparent and aligned strictly with necessity. These efforts are designed to reduce the risk of actual, potential, or perceived conflicts of interest.

In September 2007, Zimmer and the four other leading U.S. orthopaedic companies signed agreements with the federal government to resolve a Department of Justice investigation that began in March 2005, pertaining to past consulting arrangements with healthcare professionals. Under the terms of the resolution, Zimmer entered into a Deferred Prosecution Agreement with a term of 18 months and a five year Corporate Integrity Agreement, without admitting any liability and with the acknowledgement of the U.S. Attorney's Office that the Company's alleged conduct did not adversely affect patient health or patient care. As you may be aware, one of the requirements under the Deferred Prosecution Agreement is to prominently feature on the Company's public web site detailed information about financial relationships with certain healthcare professionals. Zimmer is taking this and all of its obligations under the Deferred Prosecution and Corporate Integrity Agreements extremely seriously. I attach a copy of the posting that Zimmer has made on its web site for your consideration. (Attachment 1.)

Zimmer welcomes the opportunity to share with you the progress it has made since signing its resolution agreements and to discuss the Company's commitment to go beyond the

requirements of those agreements, the AdvaMed Code and Zimmer's own enhanced Corporate Compliance Program.

At the time of the resolutions, the U.S. Attorney acknowledged that Zimmer's 2005 Corporate Compliance Program provided many of the requirements contained in the agreements the five companies entered into with the Department of Justice. Zimmer's Compliance Program is considered state-of-the-art and continues to promote best practices of the industry. It is worth noting that Zimmer has also undertaken important new initiatives in the area of compliance that are designed to further enhance its 2005 Compliance Program and exceed the requirements of its resolution agreements.

Zimmer's broader commitment to compliance and transparency in its collaborative relationships includes fundamental changes in product development, marketing, surgeon training, educational and research funding, and the ways that the Company makes these relationships transparent to the public. Although Zimmer is currently finalizing the specific strategies that will comprise this broader plan, there are a number of changes that Zimmer has already publicly committed to put in place, including:

- 1. Zimmer's sales and distribution teams and individuals with daily responsibility for sales support will have no involvement with physician consultants concerning their collaborative agreements with the Company, the services that the physicians provide for the Company, and the payments made under the agreements.
- Zimmer is reviewing its existing royalty-bearing hip and knee development agreements to ensure that they are consistent with the fair market value principles of the Company's 2005 enhanced Corporate Compliance Program and the terms of its resolution agreements. This process has begun, and Zimmer is currently communicating with physician consultants who hold these royalty-bearing agreements.
- 3. With respect to Zimmer's future funding of medical fellowships, residencies, and general educational programs, Zimmer intends to make cash donations to one or more appropriate, independent third-party institutions. These third-party institutions will choose the programs and applicants that will receive Zimmer funding globally. Zimmer will have no control or influence over the selection of the ultimate recipients of these funds. This approach makes it possible for Zimmer to continue to provide worthy support to the education of orthopaedic surgeons around the world, while eliminating any possibility for inappropriate influence.
- 4. Zimmer's future charitable activities will include product donations to one or more appropriate, independent, global third-party charitable institutions. These institutions will determine the distribution and application of these donated products in areas of the world with great unmet medical need. Again, Zimmer

will have no control over the distribution of these products and no influence over who receives them.

5. While the current AdvaMed Code of Ethics allows for certain educational, practice-related, or branded company gifts to healthcare professionals, Zimmer further restricted such gifts as part of its 2005 Corporate Compliance Program, and will now move to prohibit them altogether. In lieu of providing gifts to individual healthcare professionals, Zimmer may make cash donations to appropriate, independent third-party institutions that will then determine the dissemination of education-related items.

Zimmer has committed to implementing these improvements to its current robust compliance practices on a global basis across the Company's entire business. This commitment far exceeds the requirements of Zimmer's resolution agreements.

These new initiatives will allow Zimmer to continue to deliver industry-leading products of the highest quality backed by business practices that inspire confidence and trust. Ultimately, it is Zimmer's goal to ensure that patients benefit from innovations focused on their needs, and that everyone with a stake in quality healthcare can trust that physicians choose products based on what they believe is best for patients. As a market leader, Zimmer strongly believes that its leadership position should extend to include best practices in the areas of compliance and ethics. These best practices are necessary to ensure a vibrant future for medical technology and for the patients served by the entire industry – creating principles and systems that drive greater transparency, innovations that solve unmet patient needs, and value to the healthcare system over the long-term. Zimmer is pursuing these priorities with a commitment to ensure that when Zimmer products are chosen, it is because they are the best solution for patients. That is the sole basis upon which this Company wants to compete, and the surest path forward to ensuring confidence and trust in the industry.

Given these commitments, Zimmer is strongly supportive of the Physician Payments Sunshine Act, that aims to provide for the appropriate disclosure of relationships between medical technology companies and physicians. Zimmer believes that the goals of this legislation mirror the ideals of the Company and the medical device industry. The collective goal is to ensure the highest quality care for patients. You may be aware that Zimmer recently testified before the Senate Aging Committee, chaired by Senator Kohl, regarding the Company's commitment to transparency. In connection with that testimony, Zimmer delivered the attached letter (Attachment 2) to Senator Kohl, expressing the Company's strong support for the legislation, and setting out Zimmer's detailed views and comments on its provisions.

This strong commitment to ethical behavior and transparency is an integral part of Zimmer's business. Zimmer believes that its efforts in this area underscore and reinforce the Company's focus on developing products that enhance patients' lives. In simple terms, Zimmer believes this is the right thing to do for its patients, for the Company, and for the industry as a whole.



Dear Chairman Kohl:

On behalf of Zimmer Holdings, Inc., I am writing to express the Company's strong support for S. 2029 (Physician Payments Sunshine Act). To date, Zimmer has communicated its support in a variety of meetings on Capitol Hill, including with staff of members of the Senate Aging and Finance Committees. Zimmer has also actively supported the efforts of the medical device industry – through our trade association, AdvaMed (Advanced Medical Technology Association) – to support this proposed legislation. Nonetheless, we want to take this opportunity to formalize our position and our support.

Zimmer has, in fact, already undertaken efforts at transparency that are contemplated in the proposed legislation. Our experience complying with the terms of our resolution agreements with the U.S. Department of Justice, however, leads us to believe that the proposed legislation can and should be strengthened in a number of important areas, including the following:

• Federal preemption: The legislation should expressly preempt state laws requiring the tracking and public reporting of industry's financial relationships with physicians. Simply put, the prospect of multiple reporting systems and formats will confuse the very patients that the legislation is attempting to aid. In addition, preemption would make achieving transparency easier and more cost effective for companies of all sizes by obviating the need for companies to develop and implement different internal processes and information systems to comply with a multitude of different state laws. A single reporting system makes sense for all.

- Elimination of the sales revenue reporting exemption: The legislation should not include the reporting exemption for companies with less than \$100 million in annual revenue, or any such exemption. Patients deserve to have full disclosure and transparency. Small- to medium-sized device companies are involved in collaborative arrangements with physicians, too. If transparency is important enough for companies above this revenue threshold, then it should be equally important for companies that fall below the threshold. Legislation that contains any such exemption will effectively undermine the intent of the legislation, which is to bring to light the financial arrangements between the industry and physicians so that stakeholders can then judge whether any such arrangement presents an unnecessary and inappropriate conflict of interest. If patients have access only to information from selected companies, they cannot make informed decisions.
- Physician-owned implant companies: The legislation should require that physician-owned medical device companies, distributors or group purchasing organizations comply with the requirements of the legislation. Zimmer shares the concerns expressed by the Office of Inspector General, AdvaMed, and others that these physician-owned companies present significant conflicts of interest that may not be in the best interest of the patient. Zimmer believes patients have a right to know when their physician intends to use a medical device that is made or distributed by a company in which that physician stands to profit as a result of his or her equity ownership stake in that company.
- <u>Limit Reporting Exemptions</u>: Zimmer believes the legislation would be strengthened by limiting the number of public reporting exemptions related to industry payments to physicians. Too many unnecessary exemptions, particularly in the areas of gifts, education and training, and technical support, will only complicate industry's ability to comply with the requirements of the legislation and, most importantly, render the legislation unhelpful to patients. The inevitable loopholes created by these types of exemptions do not help anyone.
- Ensure Protection of Legal Privileges: While Zimmer does not generally support public reporting exemptions, we believe that there is one payment area that is appropriate for exemption. In the limited circumstances when a company that anticipates, or is involved in, litigation remunerates a physician for serving as an expert or fact witness or providing other, related expertise pertaining to the legal matter, such arrangements must be exempted from reporting. The public reporting of such relationships could violate attorney-client privilege and result in the unfair disclosure of legal strategies.

Zimmer appreciates the opportunity to provide constructive comments on S. 2029 and looks forward to continuing to express its strong support for the proposed legislation.
