- Process is two-phased for increased organizational security and efficiency for conducting business with the federal government.



Tips



- Follow Grantor instructions
 - Ensure you answer all the questions
 - Proofread follow fonts and formatting guidelines
- Include sufficient program details
 - Emphasize and justify significance of problem
- Be realistic
 - Do not propose more work than can be done during grant period
 - Insufficient budget
- Ensure you submit early
 - In time to meet the Grantor agency deadline
- Make a copy for your records

Tips



- Limit File Attachment Name to Under 50 Characters
- Use Numbers to Indicate Correct Sequence
- Do Not Use Any Special Characters (Ex. -, %, /, #,) or Spacing in the File Name or for Word Separation
 - The Exception is Underscore (_)

Important Reminders



- Register early
- DUNS in the application package must be the same as your AOR registration
- Follow agency instructions
- Submit early
- Announcements close in Eastern Time
- Adobe Reader 9.0 latest version
