## Browse by Agency and Sub-Agency

- Browsing by agency and sub-agency work in a similar manner with one important exception:
  - When you click on "browse by agency," the agencies are listed in alphabetical order.
  - When you click on "browse by subagency," they are NOT so you will have to scroll down the list.

- Federal Funds for Organizations That Help Those in Need
  - Click on "Grant Opportunities" at top left; click on the catalogue title; use *click here* download link below "Grants Catalogue"
- Links to the 12 federal agency FBCI Centers
  - At lower right
  - Grant opportunities, featured programs, grant writing advice, web casts, grant catalogues, email listservs

- Eligible applicants
- Good fit, not exact match
- Number, size & duration of grants
- Cost sharing requirements
- Other requirements

- Federal contact person call and ask
  - When is the next announcement?
  - How many grants?
  - Web casts, conference calls?
  - Is the prior announcement available?
  - Does your idea fit?

- Really read it, then read it again ... and again...
  - Not loose guidance the rule book
  - Allow time to become familiar with the language and requirements.
  - There can be a lot of other information referenced in the announcement. Get it!

- Compliance checklist
  - Every "should," "must," "cannot"
  - Page limits, font size, margin size
  - Required format (sequence, headings)
  - Federal budget categories
- Quality checklist
  - Every indication of a preference
  - Key concepts (words, phrases, values)

- Examples of key concepts
  - best practices
  - early intervention
  - evidence-based approach
  - leveraging resources
  - positive youth development
  - program outcomes

- Applying for a federal grant is a competition.
- Pay careful attention to the:
  - Evaluation Criteria (rating factors, review criteria)
- This is what reviewers use to score your application. High scores win!

## **Common Review Criteria**

- Documented need
- Clear, reasonable objectives
- Sound methods
- Quantified and achievable results
- Reasonable and allowable budget

## **Documented Need**

- Provide evidence not opinions. Include statistics and cite sources.
- Keep the focus as local as possible. Use national, state or other data for comparison.
- Make your case. Connect the conditions that exist and the changes you expect will result from what you do.
- Make your description interesting to read!

## **Objectives and Methods**

- Objectives are your ends.
  - To increase...To decrease...To reduce
- Methods are your means.
  - To provide...To establish...To create
- Don't confuse the two.
- Make sure that your objectives and methods are related to the need.

## **Sound Methods**

- Heart of your proposal (work plan).
   Explain activities in sufficient detail and provide a clear timeframe.
- Are all of the activities allowed?
- Is it is reasonable to expect that these activities can achieve your objectives?
- How do you know this will work?

## Quantified and Achievable Results

- <u>How much</u> you will do during the award period (number of participants, units of service, etc.) called **outputs**
- The <u>benefits</u> of your project for people/community (what will change and how) called **outcomes**; and
- Your plan for measuring both.

## **Budget**

- Reasonable, allowable, allocable
- OMB Circular A-122
- Use the federal budget categories.
- Provide a narrative budget justification with cost details and why you need this for the proposed project.
- Meet the cost sharing requirement.
- Check your math!
