

Judge Roberts, as Deputy Solicitor General, argued against *Roe v. Wade*, and also argued on behalf of Operation Rescue, an extreme anti-abortion group, in *Bray v. Alexandria*. The pro-choice loss in *Bray v. Alexandria* increased violence at clinics. In private practice, Roberts argued against affirmative action for minorities.

The Feminist Majority will continue to examine Roberts' record, and it will demand that Senators not confirm Roberts unless he makes clear that he will not reverse Roe, civil rights, women's rights, and the rights of the disabled. If Judge Roberts will not reveal his views on these fundamental women's and civil rights and the separation of church and state, Senators must vote against his confirmation.
