windlass option has been added that allows the windlass to be mounted farther aft on the deck and features a bow pulpit with the "drop-through" design for the anchor rode and anchor. A stove feature has been added to the cabin with a cover for countertop space. The cockpit of the boat has been changed so that Grady-White's patented aft folding seat (patent # 6,647,916 B2) is located on the aft cockpit wall instead of a permanent built in seat as on the previous model. The folding aft seat feature provides space to build in a fishbox across the width of the aft cockpit where the permanent seat had been located. The livewell incorporates Grady-White's unique design consisting of a full plenum water distribution system, a
