#### Metals Affordability Initiative (MAI)

One of the major challenges facing the domestic industrial base is to maintain technology leadership in strategic sectors critical to our national defense, especially in light of growing global economic pressures. The MAI consortium, established in 1999 has improved the military war fighting capability while reducing life cycle cost through technology innovation and is helping to transform the US specialty aerospace metals industry by increasing the competitiveness of this critical industrial sector.

MAI's membership includes 18 companies, along with the Air Force Research Laboratory (AFRL) at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base. In addition to the consortium members, MAI's competitively-bid projects involve participants from an additional 60 industrial companies, including over 45 small businesses, 18 universities, and three National Laboratories. A recent survey of MAI participants indicated that they reside in over 93 Congressional Districts located in 35 states, truly a national agenda.

The high success rate of MAI programs is accomplished through government/industry collaboration, which also allows leveraging of precious technical resources and financial investment. The government investment (over \$55 million to date) is supplemented by a minimum industry cost share of 25 percent (over \$24 million). MAI has demonstrated a return on government investment approaching 15:1. MAI programs have already accomplished 47 technology insertions into military systems. MAI is an outstanding example of good public policy.

The AF has recognized the excellent contribution of MAI to meeting their focused long-term challenges by continuously increasing support from limited discretionary funds (now up to \$13.5 million through FY11) for developing advanced structural metals technology. They plan to establish a stable source of funding for structural metals technology programs within their established 6.3 AFRL/RX Program Element in the FY10 President's Budget.

Therefore, we respectfully request that the Committee appropriate an additional \$14 million in FY09 to Advanced Materials for Weapon Systems, PE 0603112F, specifically for MAI. This funding will allow initiation of six new high-impact programs, as well as sustaining ongoing programs directed at sustainment/life extension, fuel savings/energy management, "green" (environmental impact) and access to space. We have attached draft Bill language for your consideration.

Dear Chairman Levin and Ranking Member McCain:

Let us begin by thanking you and the entire Committee for your support of Gulf War Illnesses research funding in last year's National Defense Authorization Act. Because of your constant efforts and those of the Appropriations Committee, \$10 million was provided to the Gulf War Veterans' Illness Research Program (GWVIRP) within the U.S. Army's Congressionally Directed Medical Research Programs (CDMRP). This funding will allow CDMRP, through its network of grant funded researchers, to continue their important work of seeking treatments for the approximately 175,000 veterans of the first Gulf War – one in four of those who served –who remain ill 17 years after the war. To fund additional pilot studies of promising new treatments and to conduct clinical trials of treatments determined to be effective in earlier pilot studies, we respectfully request that the Armed Services Committee authorize \$30 million, in addition to including the attached bill language, to continue funding this important research in FY 2009. This request has the support of the Veterans of Foreign Wars, American Legion, AMVETS, Disabled American Veterans, and Vietnam Veterans of America.

As you know, the CDMRP's Gulf War Veterans' Illness Research Program is a three year old competitive peer-reviewed program open to all researchers. The purpose of this research is to identify treatments and diagnostic markers for veterans who suffer from Gulf War Illnesses (GWI), a complex multi-symptom disorder (including widespread pain, cognitive impairment, and persistent fatigue, in conjunction with other abnormalities) associated with service in the first Gulf War.

The Research Advisory Committee on Gulf War Veterans' Illnesses, established by Congress to make recommendations on government research relating to the health consequences of Gulf War service, has determined that this condition was not caused by wartime stress, but is linked to neurotoxic chemical exposures during the war. It is critical to find treatments for these conditions, not only for Gulf War veterans, but also to protect present and future American military personnel and civilians at risk of similar health effects. Exposure to chemical agents is a constant threat for the members of the U.S. Armed Forces. DoD has historically funded two-thirds of GWI research, but with the onset of the current conflicts, GWI research was dropped from the Defense budget.

To date few Gulf War veterans have recovered and no effective treatments have been identified; however, recent research has developed important insights. Three studies released last year by a team from Boston University, the Department of Veterans Affairs, and the Army have added to the compelling body of recent scientific evidence that these illnesses are serious neurological conditions resulting from toxic exposures during the war. This research found that ill Gulf War

veterans, with five or more symptoms, showed a loss of brain mass in MRI scans of areas related to learning and memory, and also performed significantly worse on objective learning and memory tests. In addition, previous studies have shown that Gulf War veterans have double the rate of amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS) or Lou Gehrig's disease found in other veterans, and that veterans potentially exposed to low level nerve agents during the destruction of the weapons storage facility in Khamisiyah, Iraq, have double the expected rate of brain cancer deaths. This research has emphasized the alarming concern that Gulf War Illnesses may lead to these deadly diseases if effective treatments are not found.

The proposed \$30 million in authorization will build on the FY 2006 and FY 2008 programs. The initial \$5 million pilot program in FY 2006 attracted 80 proposals, demonstrating the interest of the scientific community in this work. The suggested bill language will provide the appropriate structure and guidance for this program so that this research is conducted in an open, scientifically-driven manner, with treatments for our veterans as the priority. Nine studies were ultimately funded with the \$5 million and are now underway, including proposals from public and private universities and a federal government laboratory. Four of the nine projects focus on treatments, two on diagnostic markers, and two will research both categories. CDMRP will shortly be announcing the \$10 million research program for FY 2008, which is expected to attract substantially more proposals focused on diagnosis and treatment of GWI.

This program, which is designed to provide rapid research breakthroughs to improve the health of ill Gulf War veterans, needs adequate resources to help fulfill our nation's promises to these brave veterans who have waited so long for real treatment and real answers. The first phase of research focuses on identifying promising diagnostic markers and treatments already approved for other illnesses, through small, relatively inexpensive pilot studies. In the second phase, treatments that prove effective are evaluated in larger clinical trials to determine which can be approved for clinical use. The \$30 million level supports both these phases and matches historical federal funding levels and the recommendations of the Research Advisory Committee on Gulf War Veterans' Illnesses.

In addition, in accordance with the requirements of paragraph 9 of Rule XLIV of the Standing Rules of the Senate, we certify that neither each of us, respectively, nor our respective immediate families has a pecuniary interest in the program and/or funding described in this letter.
