

CONGRESSMAN HENRY CUELLAR

Congressman Henry Cuellar was sworn into office in January 2005, and has become a strong and independent voice in Congress. Prior to his election to the U.S. House of Representatives, Congressman Cuellar served as Texas' 102nd Secretary of State and as a fourteen year member of the Texas Legislature. During his legislative career Congressman Cuellar has continuously fought to improve access to quality education and health care for all.

In his first term as U.S. Congressman for Texas District 28, he has been one of the most successful Members in Congress, and by far the most effective Representative of his freshman class. He has passed eleven out



of eleven amendments he has introduced on the House Floor- a rare accomplishment for a Member in his first term. Of first year legislators, Congressman Cuellar ranks 1st in passing amendments, and 3rd among all House Members. Congressman Cuellar has set a new standard for constituent service and producing results for his congressional district.

In the 110th Congress, he serves on the House Homeland Security, Small Business, and Agriculture Committees and serves as Senior Whip. Congressman Cuellar and his wife Imelda reside in Laredo with their two daughters, Christy and Catie.
