A REMINDER . . . TO ALL CLERKS OF THE DISTRICT AND CIRCUIT COURTS OF THE UNITED STATES:

The Copyright Act, title 17, United States Code, obligates you to do the following:

- (1) notify the Register of Copyrights of actions filed under the Copyright Act;
- (2) notify the Register of Copyrights of any final order or judgment issued in the case, within one month after the final order or judgment is issued;
- (3) send the Register of Copyrights a copy of the written opinion of the court, within one month of its issuance.
