## COPYRIGHT REVISION BILL INTRODUCED IN HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

On May 29, 1973, a bill for the general revision of the United States Copyright Law (Title 17, U.S.C.), H.R. 8186 (93d Congress, 1st Session), was introduced by Representative Bertram L. Podell of New York.

The bill is identical with its Senate counterpart, S. 1361 (93d Congress, 1st Session), introduced on March 26, 1973 by Senator John L. McClellan, chairman of the Subcommittee on Patents, Trademarks, and Copyrights of the Senate Committee on the Judiciary.

H.R. 8186 is similar to H.R. 2512 (90th Congress, 1st Session) which was passed by the House of Representatives in April 1967.
