

Dear Copyright Office,

The DMCA is far too restrictive to the lawful use of purchased media. If I purchase media designed for my own personal use, I should feel free from legal ramifications to use that media in a personal/non-commercial manner.

To limit it's use to approved "players" is a blow to my personal rights as a consumer. I have the right, once purchased, to enjoy that media for personal use, to play my purchased copy of that media using whatever hardware or software package I wish.

The DeCSS case is one based on whether the above right exists or not. I believe it does exist. As long as I do not use that media for commercial gains, and limit it to my own personal use, I am within the law.
