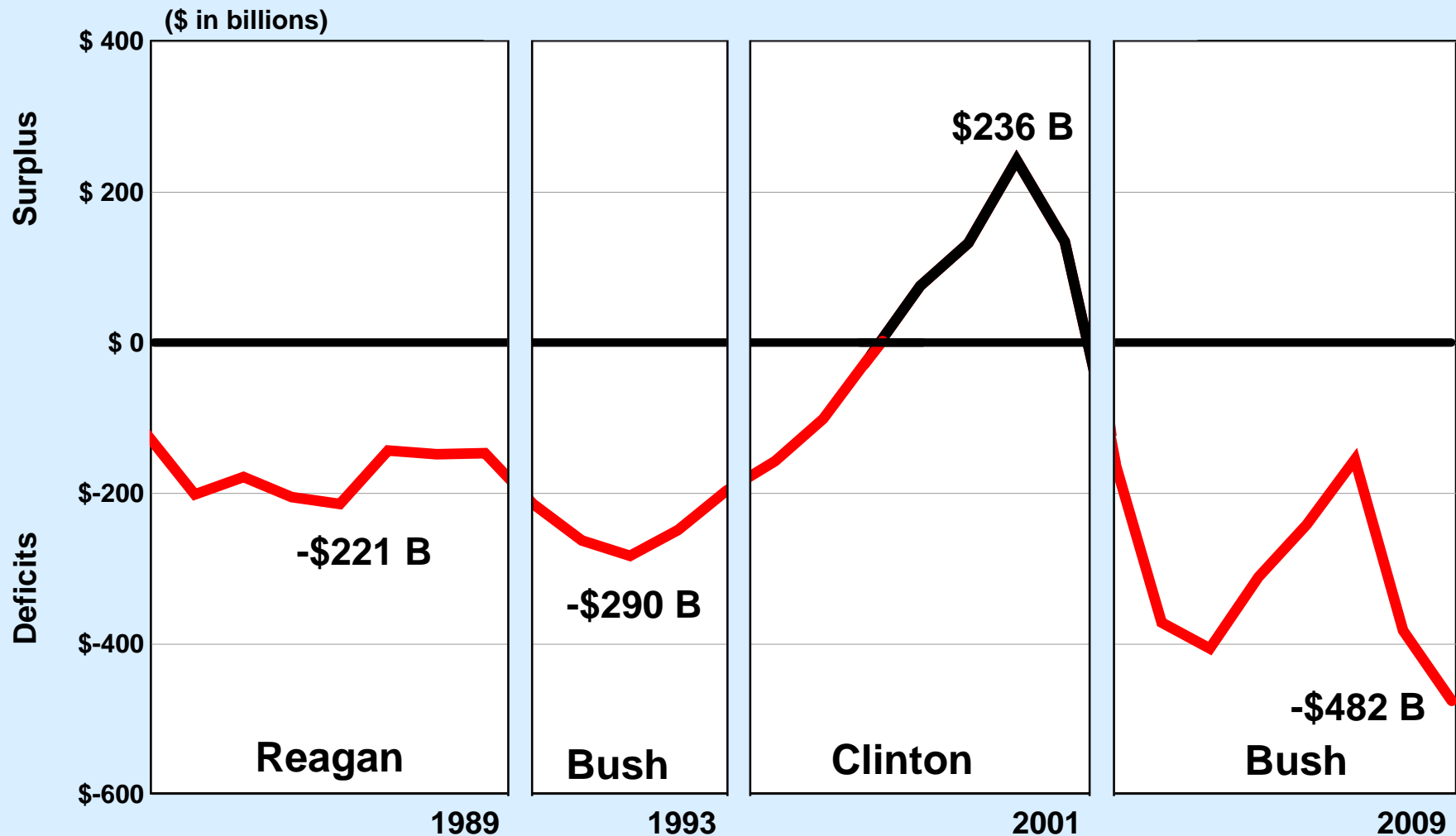

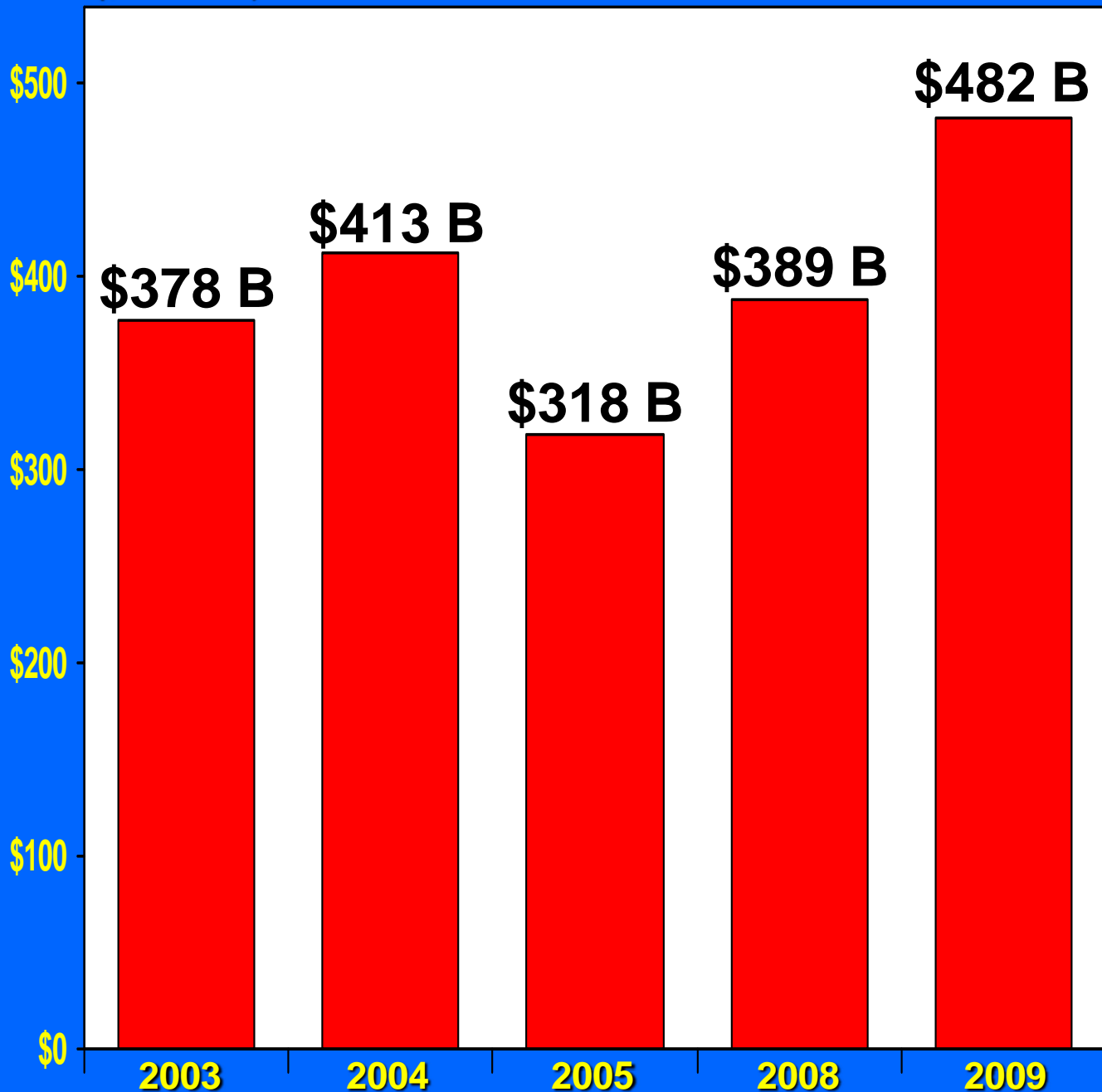

*All Under President Bush*

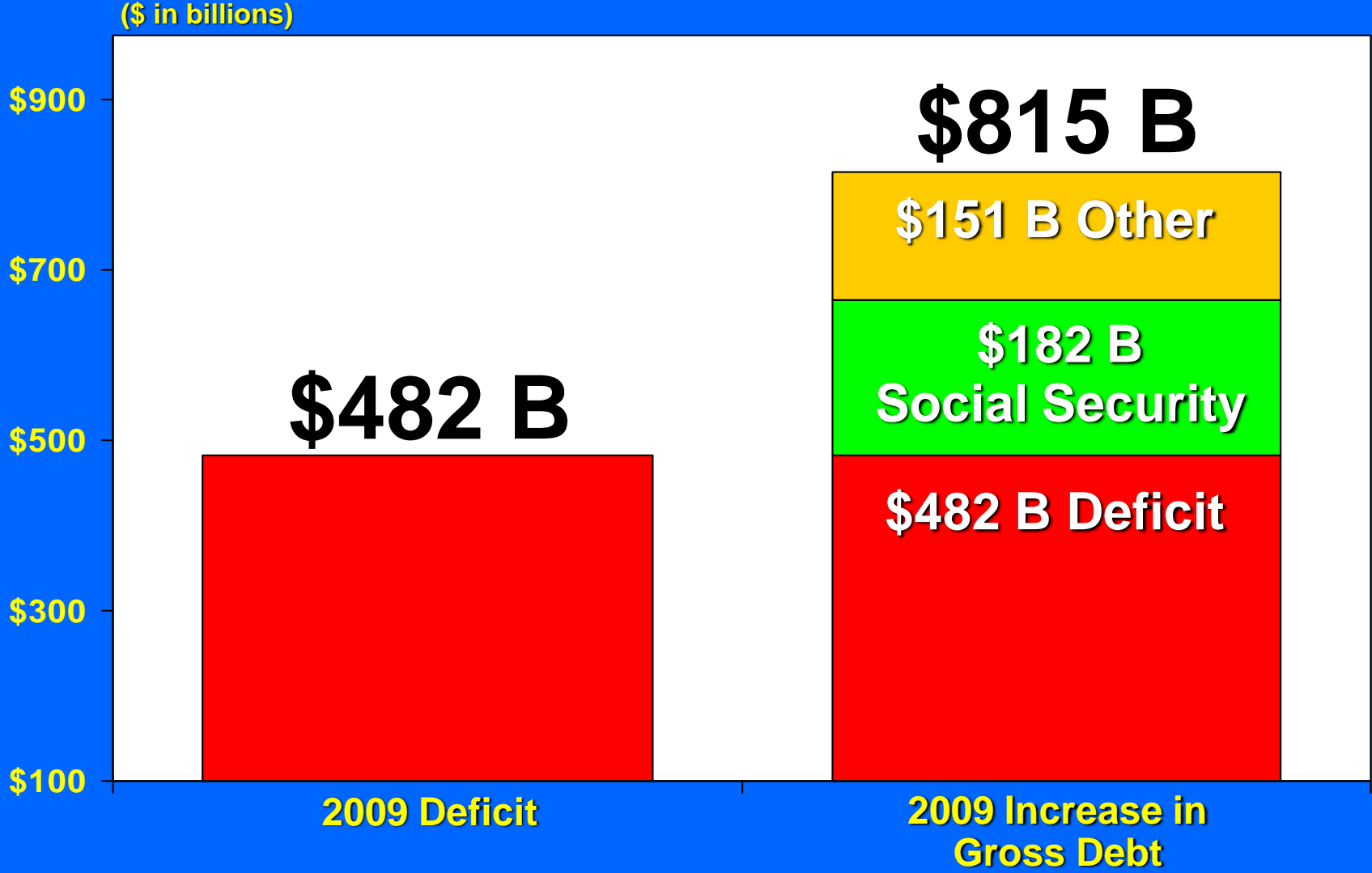
(\$ in billions)

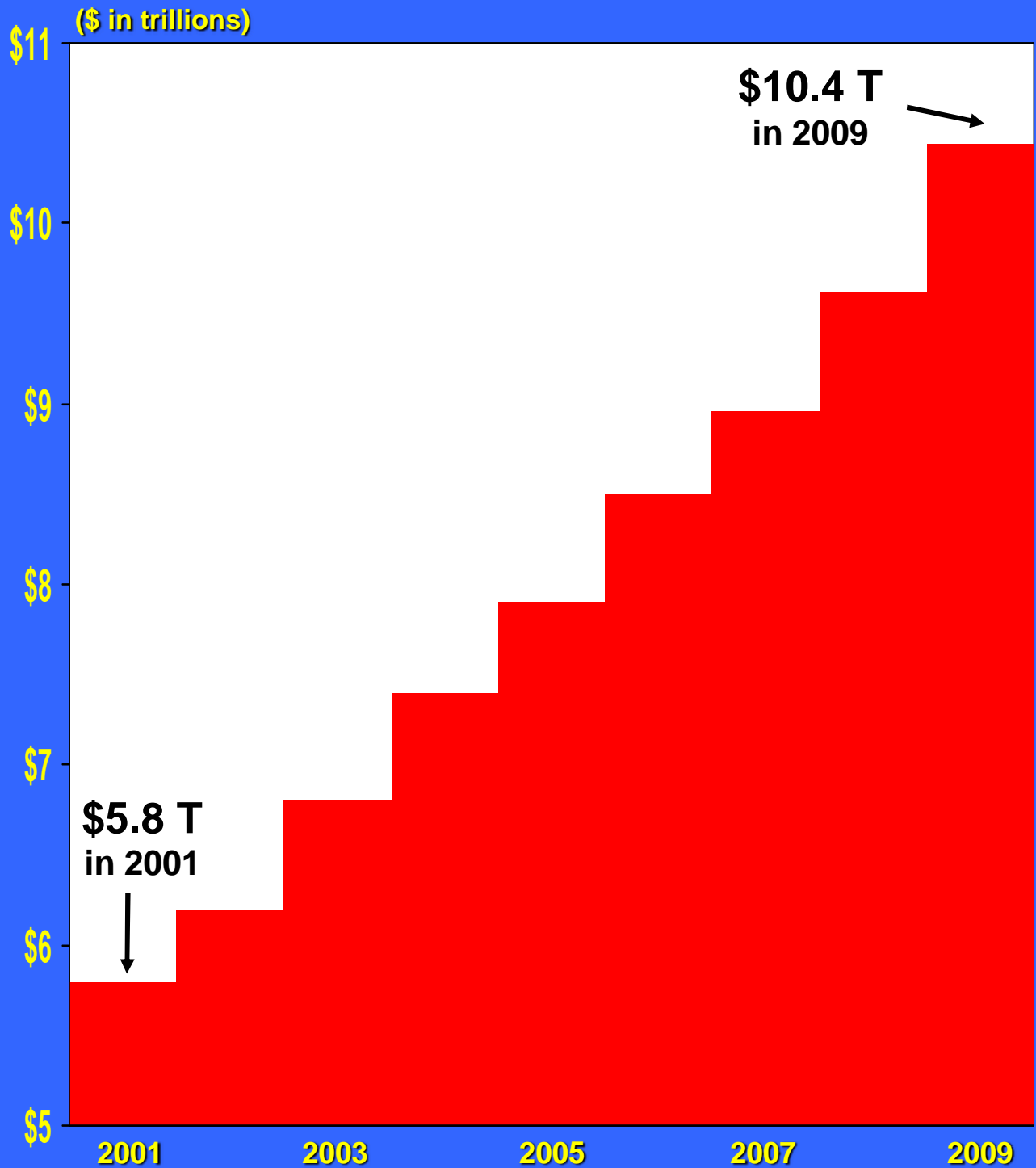
# Increase in Debt in 2009 is Far Greater Than the \$482 Billion Deficit
