PLATINUM-GROUP METALS IN OCTOBER 2007

According to Platts Metals Week, the October average price of platinum increased 8% as compared with that of September, and the palladium average price increased 9% over the same time period. The iridium price has not changed since February 13, remaining at \$450 per troy ounce. The October average price of ruthenium increased 16% as compared with that of September, and the rhodium average price increased slightly over the same time period.

Production from the Stillwater Mining Company's (SMC) (Billings, MT) two mines for the third quarter was 3,070 kilograms (kg) of palladium and 929 kg of platinum, down 15% and 14%, respectively, as compared with production in the third quarter 2006. During the third quarter, the Stillwater Mine produced 22% less palladium and platinum as compared with that of the third quarter 2006, owing to a 7-day mineworker's strike and lower productivity that resulted from new equipment and new mineworkers. The smaller East Boulder Mine was

unaffected by the labor issues, and production increased slightly in the third quarter as compared with that of third quarter 2006. SMC mine production for the first 9 months in 2007 was 9,700 kg of palladium and 2,900 kg of platinum, 9% and 8% lower, respectively, as compared with that of the first 9 months 2006. Stillwater recycling activities increased to 3,070 kg of palladium, platinum, and rhodium, up 9% as compared with that of third quarter 2006 because of a new supply source. For the first 9 months, SMC produced 8,670 kg of palladium, platinum, and rhodium from recycled material, 17% more than that of the first 9 months of 2006 (Stillwater Mining Company, 2007).
