## SODA ASH IN OCTOBER 2008

U.S. natural soda ash production in October was 988,000 metric tons (t), 5.6% higher than the previous month's production of 935,000 t, according to the U.S. Geological Survey.

Ending inventories for October 2008 were 241,000 t, 9% lower than the preceding month's inventories. Wyoming trona production in October was 1.5 million metric tons. Total production of chemical caustic soda was withheld to avoid disclosing company proprietary data.

Apparent consumption of soda ash in September 2008 was 475,000 t, 4% higher than in September 2007, and ending stocks were 6% higher.

Exports and imports of soda ash in August 2008 were 417,000 t and 658 t, respectively.

Cumulative soda ash statistics from January through September 2008, compared with those of January through September 2007, were as follows: production was slightly higher; imports were 44% higher; exports were 3% higher; and apparent consumption, 3% lower. Although imports have risen dramatically in 2008 compared with those of 2007, they still represent less than 1% of apparent consumption.

All percentages in this report were computed using unrounded data.
