


Historic Maps Available from the FEMA Map Service Center

- Historic maps may be found using product catalog on the MSC website.


How to Create a FIRMette for Historic Maps

Historic Flood Maps are digital (raster) images of Flood Hazard Boundary Maps (FHBMs) and Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMs) that are no longer the most recently issued version. **Note that these maps may no longer be the official, effective flood maps.**

Follow the steps below:












Step 4: Choose the panel that you wish to view, and click the green button. (If there is no green button, the FIRM is not available for viewing.)


