### **ATF OFFERS \$10,000 REWARD IN MACHINE GUN HEIST**

Philadelphia – Mark W. Potter, Special Agent in Charge of the Philadelphia Division of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF), announced today that ATF is offering a \$10,000 reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of those responsible for the burglary of over 20 firearms, to include numerous machine guns, that occurred December 21 from a truck parked in a King of Prussia, Pa., parking lot.

The firearms were stolen from the vehicle of a federally licensed gun dealer from the Pittsburgh, Pa., area. The dealer had finished working at a gun show at the Valley Forge Convention Center and had stopped for dinner when the theft occurred.
