Electronic submissions via email are preferred.

- Manuscripts should be 3,000 to 5,000 words in length.
- Include a cover letter. To be considered for publication, authors must state that the manuscript is not under consideration by another publication.
- Submit a complete biography with author contact information (that is, complete mailing address, telephone, fax, and email).
- Submit your manuscript as a Microsoft *Word* document (*.doc) file.
- Please consult *The Chicago Manual of Style*, 15th ed., for endnote style.
- Submit graphics, tables, and charts with source references in separate files from the manuscript (that is, do not embed graphics). Ensure that the text file has placeholders for the graphics, tables, and charts.
- JFQ may accept high resolution (300 dpi or greater) digital photos; be sure to include caption and photographer’s credit. Prints and 35mm transparencies are also acceptable. JFQ will return photos, if possible.

All submissions will be reviewed in a timely manner. *Manuscripts exceeding the word count may be rejected or returned to the author for revision before further consideration.*

JFQ reserves the right to edit all contributions. JFQ will attempt to afford authors an opportunity to review the final edited version; request for changes must be received by the given deadline.

All submissions are submitted to the Office of the Secretary of Defense for security review. No payments or honoraria are authorized for publication of articles. Material appearing in the journal is considered in the public domain and is not protected by copyright. Selected articles do not necessarily reflect the position of the Department of Defense, Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, or National Defense University.
