

USAFRICOM Concept


- □ U.S. Africa Command will support U.S. Government activities across Africa to:

- □ Goal is significant inter-agency representation from the beginning




Draft Area of Responsibility

AFRICOM Tasks

- Work with African states, regional organizations, and other partners to:
 - Build Partnership Capacity
 - Support USG agencies in implementing security policies
 - Conduct Theater Security Cooperation activities
 - Increase partner counter-terrorism skills
 - Enhance humanitarian assistance, disaster mitigation, and response activities
 - Foster respect for human rights
 - Support African regional organizations
 - As directed, conduct military operations



Draft Mission Statement

US Africa Command promotes US National Security objectives by working with African states and regional organizations to help strengthen stability and security in the AOR. US Africa Command leads the in-theater DoD response to support other USG agencies in implementing USG security policies and strategies. In concert with other U.S. government and international partners, US Africa Command conducts theater security cooperation activities to assist in building security capacity and improve accountable governance. As directed, US Africa Command conducts military operations to deter aggression and respond to crises.
