Public Meeting for Proposed Lake on Murder Creek in Conecuh County, Alabama

Mobile, Ala. – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Mobile District, announced that it will hold a public meeting as part of the scoping process during the preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS). The public is invited to participate in the scoping meeting which will provide information regarding a proposed private 2,650-acre lake on Murder Creek, northwest of the City of Evergreen, Conecuh County, Alabama. The private applicant is the Conecuh County Commission, and the Corps is the lead federal agency with the responsibility of evaluating the environmental impacts of the proposed project. The meeting will also provide an opportunity for the public to make comments and ask questions regarding the project and EIS process to the Corps.

The meeting will be held using an open house format allowing time for participants to review specific information and provide comments to the resource staff at the meeting. The meeting date and location is as follows:
