PHILADELPHIA (Aug. 14, 2008): The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers today announced that nine Philadelphia District employees and an employee from the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission were selected for Department of the Army awards.

Park rangers rescued a woman from the Blue Marsh Lake June 25 after her watercraft collided with another personal watercraft. Rangers performed in-water stabilization of the victim before transporting her by boat to awaiting EMS services on shore.
