AMENDED OFFICIAL BANKRUPTCY FORMS EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 1, 2007

The Judicial Conference of the United States has approved revisions to certain Bankruptcy Official Forms to take effect December 1, 2007.

- Official Form 5, Involuntary Petition
- Official Form 6, Summary of Schedules and Statistical Summary of Certain Liabilities, including Schedules A through J
- Official Form 7, Statement of Financial Affairs
- Official Form 10, Proof of Claim
- Proposed Official Form 19, Declaration and Signature of Non-Attorney Bankruptcy Petition Preparer: *This form would replace Forms 19a and 19B, which are proposed to be abrogated.*
- Official Form 21, Statement of Social-Security Number
- Official Form 23, Debtor's Certification of Completion of Instructional Course Concerning Personal Financial Management
