Elimination of Redundant Paper Noticing

CM/ECF gives the Clerk's Office the ability to provide registered e-filers with electronic notice through e-mail. In accordance with the Administrative Procedures for the Filing, Signing and Verifying Documents by Electronic Means in Texas Bankruptcy Courts effective December 1, 2004, registered electronic filers consent to receive electronic notice from the court in lieu of notice by first class mail. Therefore, the additional notice provided in paper through the Bankruptcy Noticing Center ("BNC") is redundant and unnecessary.

Effective August 5, 2005 additional duplicate notice provided in paper to registered e-filers by the Clerk's Office through the Bankruptcy Noticing Center ("BNC") will be eliminated, except for the Notice of the First Meeting of Creditors. The Notice of the First Meeting of Creditors will continue to be sent by the BNC through the mail, as well as by e-mail, as this notice provides parties with the debtor(s)' complete social security number.

Registered e-filers with a current EDI Trading Partner Agreement should notify the court by e-mail at txwb_systems@txwb.uscourts.gov to continue to receive a data stream through the BNC for 341 notices and discharges.
