The Guest House Regulations

Arriving brother – Welcome

We are here [at the guest house] to serve you and facilitate all your needs, personal matters, transfers or medical treatment, and to serve you better you should abide by the following rules and regulations:

- Follow the guest house instructions and procedures.
- Do not leave the guest house with out the permission of the supervisor or his assistant.
- For security reasons, do not visit and leave the guest house frequently.
- Do not speak or consult with the Afghan workers. If you have any questions please ask the guest house supervisor first.
- Keep the guest house clean. Throw your trash in the trash specified areas.
- Do not enter certain areas such as the kitchen, the admin office and the storage room.
- Use your time efficiently during your stay in the guest house. Read the Koran, pray and use our library. Please make sure to return all books orderly to their location
- It is forbidden to discuss the ideology of any religious school of thoughts, sects, group issues or organizational topics of any type. It is also forbidden to criticize any figure, scholar, leader, Mujahideen or any type of personality's behavior. If you have the knowledge and education to substantiate the truth between good and the evil based on the Shari'a, please come forward to the administration office to coordinate with us on your knowledge and we will be grateful for you for that.
- The guest can't exceed his visit for more than a day and a half [1 ½ days] unless a special permission from the dispatcher was submitted.
- Please refrain from undue consumption of the guest-house utilities. Do not talk, get into discussions or make jokes frequently. We advise and warn you not to get into Shari'a discussions.
- Read the instruction posted on the board and comply with all of the guest house procedures
- We are here to assist you and help you achieve your goals, so do not be negative, use our advice and do not hesitate to tell us what we can do to help you better. We are open for any suggestions
