

U.S. Army Corps of Engineers hosts special hog hunting opportunity at Lavon Lake

FORT WORTH, Texas – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Lavon Lake, announced today that a special hog hunting opportunity will open Feb. 1 and run through March 31, 2007. Permits will be awarded on a first-come first-serve basis to individuals who complete the hunting permit application. The hunting area will be divided into sections of approximately 400-600 acres and permitted hunters will have access to these areas. Certain special harvest methods will be allowed. This hunting opportunity is being held to help reduce the population of hogs around the lake. Federal and state hunting laws will apply.
