Construction delays result in re-opening of North Holiday Park at Benbrook Lake in early March

FORT WORTH, Texas – Construction delays have pushed back re-opening of North Holiday Park at Benbrook Lake until early March. During this time, visitors to Benbrook Lake who wish to engage in day use activities may still do so at other day use areas around the lake, including Mustang, Rocky Creek, Longhorn, Dutch Branch, and Pecan Valley Parks.

Because of the delay, the new fee structure originally set to begin January 1 will be implemented on March 26, 2007. At that time, users to North Holiday Park will be charged \$3 per car, \$1 per person if walking in, or \$1 if on bicycle. Golden Age/Access and America the Beautiful Senior/Access Passport discounts will apply and Annual Day Use Passes will be available for \$30. This pass entitles the holder and all accompanying passengers in the vehicle to use Corps of Engineers operated boat ramps and day use areas free of charge for one year from the date of purchase.

Also, in order to maintain a consistent fee program lake-wide, on March 26, 2007, Mustang and Rocky Creek Parks will begin charging \$3 per car, \$1 per person if walking in, or \$1 if on bicycle for those accessing day use facilities within these parks. Camping fees will be unaffected, and campers will not be charged an extra \$3.
